

List of organizations in the Netherlands collecting donations to help Ukraine



Netherlands4Ukraine

is a Dutch ANBI non-profit organization based in Amsterdam, founded by Dutch and Ukrainians. NL4UA is organising treatment for Ukrainian patients (veterans and civilians) in the Netherlands; actively supports the Ukrainian medical sector, and provides humanitarian aid to vulnerable people.



Open Door Ukraine

Open Door Ukraine (ODU) was founded in 2019. Since the Russian invasion of February 2022, we have multiplied our humanitarian and early reconstruction activities to help the affected Ukrainian population and repair the damage of the war.



Ukrainians in the Netherlands Foundation

Supports the needs of the Dutch Ukrainian diaspora and is also working tirelessly to counter the catastrophic consequences of Russia's war on Ukraine. The foundation is cooperating with the Embassy of Ukraine in the Kingdom of the Netherlands.



Stichting Zeilen Van Vrijheid (The Sails of Freedom Foundation)

A non-profit organisation registered in The Netherlands. They deliver ambulances, priority emergency vehicles, medical and humanitarian aid to Ukraine with minimal delays, to places where they are needed the most.



Stichting Volya Ukraine

Volya Ukraine is an initiative of a group of colleagues working at Iquality. The Foundations helps Ukrainians to survive these hard times. To be safe and healthy, to get life supplies and to renovate the country's economy and infrastructure.



The Leeuw Kyiv Foundation

Originally founded in 2006 by the Dutch community in Kyiv for the education of Dutch language and culture. But now they are fully committed to humanitarian aid.



Stichting Oekraïense Club

The Foudation actively helps Ukrainian defenders and Ukraine. They collect funds and buy everything necessary to protect and preserve the lives of Ukrainian defenders. They collect humanitarian aid and find ways to deliver it to the most affected parts of Ukraine.



VATAHA Foundation

Initiates and supports projects to spread Ukrainian art and culture in The Netherlands. By connecting artists, cultural producers and audiences, they build bridges between cultures and create opportunities for creative Ukrainians.



DroneAid

Empowers displaced Ukrainians to aquire new technical skills. During the drone building workshops, participants learn the basics of electronics and practical skills like soldering. Afterwards, the drones are donated to friends and relatives in the Ukrainian Armed Forces to aid with surveillance, reconnaissance, and other missions.



Eyes on Ukraine

Eyes on Ukraine strives to get as many video drones as possible in the air over places in Ukraine where fighting is taking place, so that the truth is not lost in this war.

**Haarlem4Ukraine**

Working as a connecting link between local community initiatives in Haarlem, refugees and non-profit organisations in Ukraine. Help to fund medical equipment and supplies through MedHelpDnipro.

**Stichting Soloveyko**

The Soloveyko Foundation was founded after spontaneously organizing benefit concerts in response to the war in Ukraine. This led to a meeting of Dutch and Ukrainian musicians, resulting in mutual enrichment: the Ukrainian musicians found strength in their contribution to humanitarian aid to their country and the Dutch musicians discovered a new rich culture that resonates with the Dutch public.

**Freedom for Ukraine**

The foundation has direct contacts at the front and in the hospitals. Since the outbreak of the war, they have already managed to send a large number of medicines, bandages, an ambulance, bulletproof vests, helmets, sleeping bags, food and other materials to Ukraine, and will continue to do so until the war is won.

**Stichting Hulp voor Oekraïne**

The Aid for Ukraine Foundation collects food, care products, clothing and other humanitarian goods to help refugees and people in Ukraine. They use financial donations to buy food in larger quantities and finance transport to Ukraine. From the sorting center in Vught, trucks with relief supplies leave directly to the areas at the front, where people have nothing left.

**Stichting Spoetnik**

The Sputnik Foundation is a humanitarian organization that provides aid and projects in Ukraine. It mainly does its work in collaboration with Ukrainian organizations on site. Every year, Sputnik provides several dozen aid transports for the benefit of children's homes, psychiatric and other medical institutions, etc.

**Lifeline Ukraine**

Providing demand-driven material humanitarian aid to those Ukrainians who do not receive large scale support; Helping vulnerable small-sized women- and family-owned businesses; Supporting the veteran community; Contributing to early reconstruction efforts; Providing a practical platform in Ukraine for Dutch organizations in need of project support in UA.

**Help4Ukraine**

They have 3 projects: Food Aid, Medical Aid and Animal Aid. Donations will be spent to pay for the transportation of food to Ukraine or to buy medical equipment for Ukrainian hospitals or to buy food for animals. 100% of the money donated and all the relief supplies we collect go to Ukraine.

**The Ukraine Needs Help Foundation**

founded in 2007 and aims to provide (medical) relief supplies free of charge to medical and social institutions in Ukraine and in particular Ukrainian hospitals, to improve patient care and living conditions. In addition, schools, the elderly and people in need are helped.

**Stichting Samen voor Oekraïne**

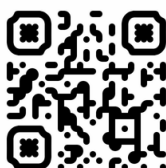

**Protect Ukraine**

From a private, ad-hoc initiative by friends and family, to a coordinated effort, such as the selfless drivers who help us to drive pick-up trucks and essential goods to Ukraine.

**Friese Rijders Foundation**

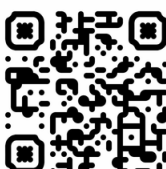
Aims to provide assistance to Ukrainian refugees both inside and outside Ukraine. They do this by organizing relief transports, drawing attention through various media and all other actions that fit this goal.

**Steun Oekraïne**

The mission at Support Ukraine is simple but powerful: they are determined to help for as long as needed, where the need is greatest. They believe in the right of every child to have a safe and healthy environment. That is why they specifically focus on supporting children affected by the war in Ukraine. But of course, displaced people and the elderly can also count on support.

**Strong Through Art**

Several projects helping Ukrainian children: partnership with a Ukrainian NGO known as Tabletochki, which provides essential support to children battling cancer; the New Dawn project - a groundbreaking social project dedicated to creating a brighter future for children and communities in the heart of Ukraine.

**Emile Foundation**

Emile Foundation is working to find and return Ukrainian children, deported and abducted by Russia, as well as increase awareness on the topic, so that those crimes are recognised by international institutions and brought to justice at the International Criminal Court soon.

**Franky en Coen**

Franky and Coen travel time and again to the front areas in eastern Ukraine to help refugees, children and soldiers and provide them with free fries and snacks. Per day, they give away up to 2000 portions of fries.

**Keep them Warm**

Keep Them Warm is an initiative of a group of students from Leiden. The primary goal is to deliver essential goods to the Polish/Ukrainian border, provide humanitarian aid and facilitate the transport of Ukrainian refugees back to the Netherlands and guarantee a safe place for them to stay.
